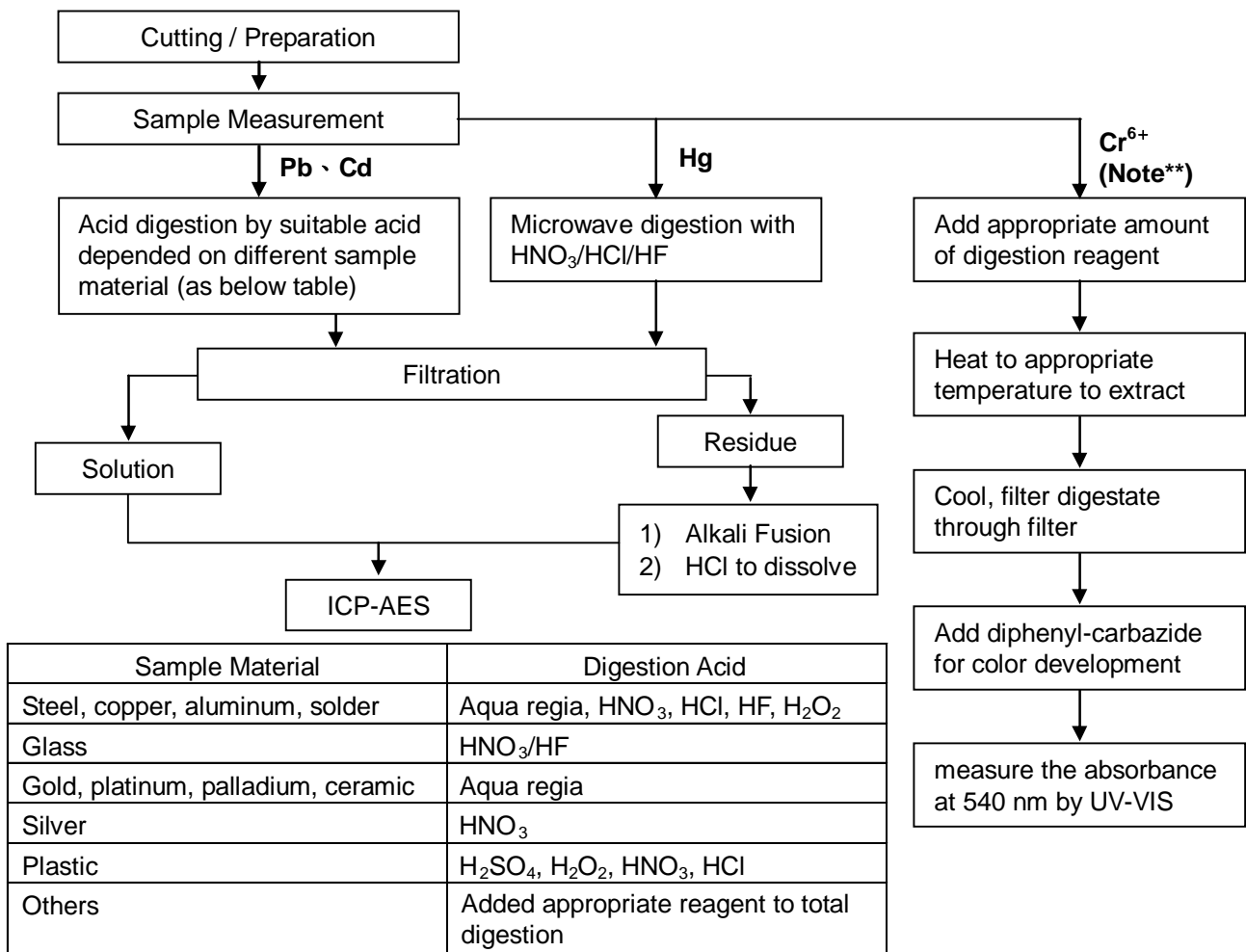
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These samples were dissolved totally by pre-conditioning method according to below flow chart.

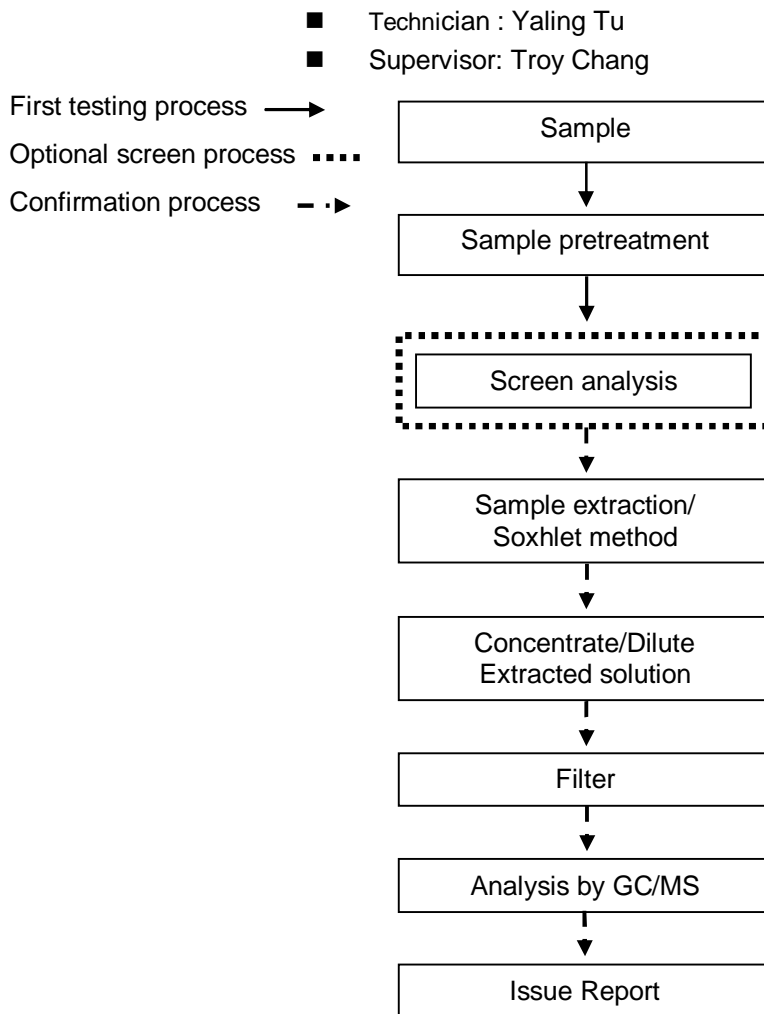


Note (For IEC 62321)**

Analytical flow chart - PBB/PBDE



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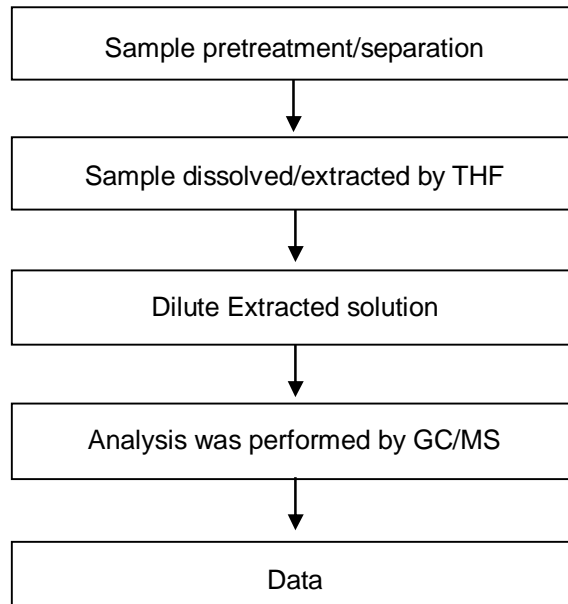
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Analytical flow chart - Phthalate

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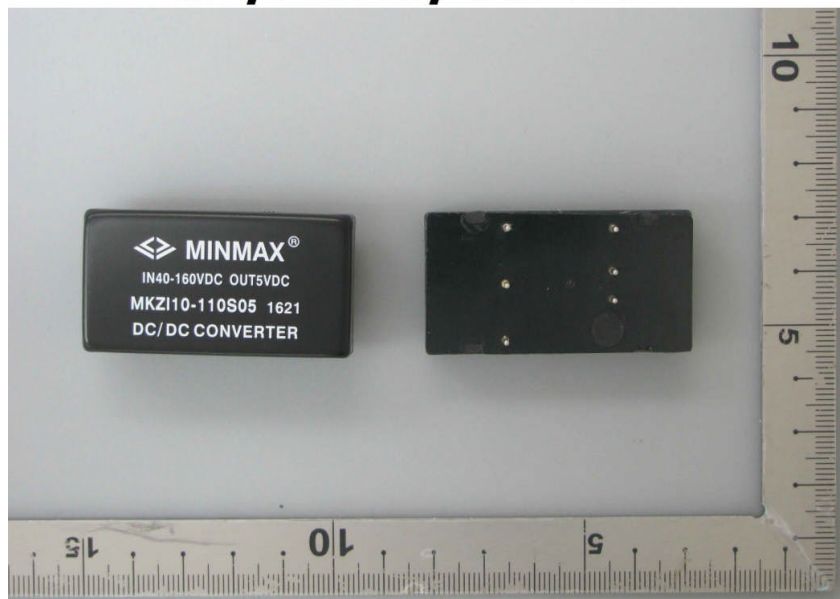
